MAYOR’S COMMENTS/CORRESPONDENCE:

- *Anita Wagner was introduced by the mayor as the new member of the library board. Anita said a few words and thanked everyone.*
- *Special Environmental Presentation – Anna and Maria, village residents regarding air quality in the village and issue of WestRock not having proper filtration. Strong odors and pollution seem to be coming from the factory. Tests should be done in that area in through the entire village.*

Also, an impoundment program will be able to be used. These are illegal to drive on roads and especially sidewalks. Comments from Code Enforcer Lepetich and board.
